OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Finger paints

8x11 black/grey background

stick glue

STEP 1

Cut a Tree out so it fits in 8x11 piece of paper. I stretched the tree so it is a skinny tree. I cut 2 trees on a 12x12 piece of paper. Cut them out and paste to a black or grey background.

STEP 2

It gets a little messy with the finger paints so have children dress appropriately. I used an old dress shirt and button in the back. layout news paper and let the kids use fall colors and paint as they like.

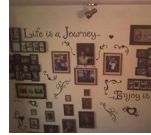
