#### STEP 1

Cricut® Cuts:  
Pirates and Mermaids Cartridge

1. Pirate

a. Turquoise base (5 1/4")

b. White Sword (5 1/4")

c. Dark brown hair (5 1/4" Shift +)

d. Brown accessories (5 1/4" Layer +)

e. Tan flesh (5 1/4" Layer + Shift +)

f. White buckle (5 1/4" Layer + Shift +)

2. Flag

a. Light turquoise shadow (3")

b. Dark brown flag (2 1/2")

Cricut Craft Room® Basics Exclusive

3. Title: PARTY

a. White title (1/2" Shift + or title of choice)

## STEP 2

Use paper trimmer to cut one 12" x 11" piece of brown cardstock. Fold in half to create card base.

## STEP 3

Use paper trimmer to cut one 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 10  $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of brown striped pattern paper. Adhere to card front.

## STEP 4

Create pirate from cuts 1a-1f. Layer together. Use foam squares to adhere to card front.

## STEP 5

Create flag from cuts 2a-2b. Layer together. Use foam squares to adhere to card front.

## STEP 6

Create title from cuts 3a. Adhere to card front.

## STEP 7

Embellish as desired.
