### OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

White Card Stock

Ribbon for bow

Glue

Close to My Heart Artiste

Brad for door knob

2.5" wide Drywall mess

Bling for flower centers

### PROJECT CUT FILES

#### STEP 1

Using the Cricut Craft Room, cut out all of the pieces in the attached CCR file.

#### STEP 2

Glue the mesh to the back of the door by running atg adhesive along the sides of the door and around its openings. Snip off the overhang. There should be very little.

#### STEP 3

Add the brad to the door knob. I glued its back so it would not wobble for my brad was a small one.

## STEP 4

Add the wreath base to the door where you like it, then add the flowers on top of it, going around the wreath. Leave an opening at the bottom for the bow. Add bling to the center of each flower.

## STEP 5

Adhere door to card base in the center

## STEP 6

Tie a bow with the ribbon and then use a glue dot to add it to the bottom of the wreath.
