Shine them on walls and ceilings and tell spooky stories! Kids will love the fun shapes that flash around them!

OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

White Posterboard

Flashlight

STEP 1

Find a flashlight with a medium sized head and lens. Measure the diameter of the lens.

STEP 2

Using Cricut Craft Room, make a circle the size of the diameter. Place an image inside the circle. I used the Movable Monsters Cricut Craft Room Exclusive cartridge and welded all of the images together to make them a full body instead of individual parts.

STEP 3

Cut out the design on white posterboard. This makes it sturdier so it will hold up better when kids play with them.

STEP 4

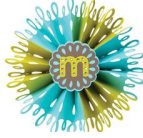
Place the posterboard disk on top of your flashlight and point towards the ceilings and walls! Kids will love how the images magically appear on the walls!
