## OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Card Stock

Crinkle Ribbon

Wire

Foil Card Stock

Adhesives

12x12 canvas

Glossy Accents

Distress Inks

## PROJECT CUT FILES

### STEP 1

Layer the paper on canvas, cut the images from the CCR.

### STEP 2

Cut the Birdhouse off the branch, then ink the branch and fray the edges. The base is just 2 scraps that I inked and criss crossed. I wrapped the crinkle ribbon around the base before I added it. Don't forget to save the pieces that you cut from the branch to use as the pine needles that are on the ground! :D  
Cut a little ornament, I used glossy accents on mine to make it shiny. I used some wire to make it look like it's hanging from the tree.

### STEP 3

I finished it by adding the Merry Christmas cut. It is from a "cake" cart, but there are many other carts that have the sentiment. See my blog for more pictures and details!
