OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

foam squares

ribbon

cuttlebug

chip board from Art Philosophy

3 colors of cardstock

adhesive

ink

PROJECT CUT FILES

 [Valentine Banner.ccr](#)

STEP 1

Cut out all pieces from cut file. Adhere the bottom paper to the chipboard and then ink the edges.



STEP 2

Put the top pieces thru the cuttle bug with folder of choice, I used a hearts folder by Paper Studio. Adhere that top piece to the frame piece. I have a video on my blog here to show you. <http://melodylannedesigns.blogspot.com/2013/01/valentine-love-banner.html>



STEP 3

Adhere just the top of the letter to the top piece.



STEP 4

Turn your piece over and add foam squares or pop dots.



STEP 5

Run ribbon thru the holes. Embellish as you like.

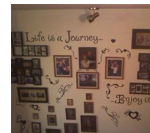
