OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Valentine Fabric

Sewable Fabric Stiffener

White Heat Transfer Vinyl

Batting

White Fabric

Trim

Iron

STEP 1

Pick out a Valentine themed fabric and white fabric. Heat on the fabric stiffener with an iron. Place your fabric on a 12 x24 mat and cut a heart. I used my Gypsy so I could make my heart as big as it would fit on a 12 x24 mat.

STEP 2

Once the hearts are cut out, sew the two hearts together and add a cute trim.

STEP 3

Cut out "Love" using the Extreme Fonts cartridge on white Heat Transfer Vinyl. I welded my letters together using Cricut Craftroom, so it would be one piece.

STEP 4

Weed the vinyl and iron it on to your heart.

STEP 5

Display proudly for Valentine's Day!
