## STEP 1

**Cricut® Cuts:**  
Use project cut file (CCR file) to create cuts.

1. Mailbox
  - a. Polka dot sides (TI Dot Ptn layer)
  - b. Hinged door/curved top/front/back (Teal CS 1 layer)
  - c. Four inner sides (Teal CS 2 layer)
  - d. Bottom (Teal CS 3 layer)

2. Hearts  
a. Two pink glitter hearts (Pnk Gltr layer)

## STEP 2

Create mailbox from cuts 1a-1d. Fold and assemble.

## STEP 3

Create hearts from cuts 2a. Adhere to mailbox.

## STEP 4

Adhere journaling card to mailbox.

## STEP 5

Use paper trimmer to cut one 1 3/4" x 5 1/2" and one 1 3/4" x 11 3/4" piece of pink pattern paper, and one 1 3/4" x 5 1/2" and one 1 3/4" x 11 3/4" piece of heart pattern paper. Layer together. Use sewing machine as desired. Score and fold. Adhere to mailbox.

Embellish as desired.
