OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Cardstock

Ribbon

Flower bud brads plain brad

Craft shaping tools

Pom Pom Trim

Stacking Boxes

Craft Shaping Mat

Glue

PROJECT CUT FILES

STEP 1

Cut straight strips of paper the width of your box lids, using box lid for a template, cut oval to cover top of box. Glue to boxes, add pom pom trim and ribbon.

STEP 2

Using Flower Shoppe Cut: Mum 2, Mum 3, Mum 4 all at 2 5/8", again at 2" and 1", cut Mum 5 at 2" (cut 4), 1.5" (cut 4) and 1.25" (cut 4). Shape flowers using craft shaping mat and tools. Assemble flowers using brads for centers. Arrange leaves and flowers on box lids and glue in place
