4" tiles (4)

Popsicle stick

Photocopier

Adhesive felt pads (16)

Sealant

Mod Podge

Printing paper

Black cardstock (1)

STEP 1

Paper Lace Cartridge

1. Geometric design (page 29 in handbook)
 - a. Black geometric design (4" <Geo1>)
2. Quilt design (page 24 in handbook)
 - a. Black quilt design (4" <Quilt1>)
3. Oval design (page 28 in handbook)
 - a. Black oval design (4" <Mod1>)

Paper Lace 2 Cartridge

4. Circle design (page 22 in handbook)
 - a. Black circle design (4" <Circle1>)

STEP 2

Pre-heat oven to 170° F.

STEP 3

Use Mod Podge to coat tiles. Set aside to dry.

STEP 4

Create geometric design from cut 1a, quilt design from cut 2a, oval design from cut 3a, and circle design from cut 4a.

STEP 5

Photocopy all cuts. Use paper trimmer to cut printed designs.

STEP 6

Coat printed designs with Mod Podge. Place face down onto tiles. Use popsicle stick to smooth out.

STEP 7

Bake tiles for 20 minutes, allowing design to transfer to Mod Podge. Let cool.

STEP 8

Run tiles under water for a few seconds. Pat dry. Use fingers to rub paper off tiles.

STEP 9

Use sealant to coat tiles. Let dry.

STEP 10

Adhere felt pads to bottom corners of tiles.

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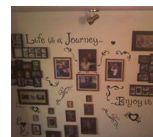
