## STEP 1

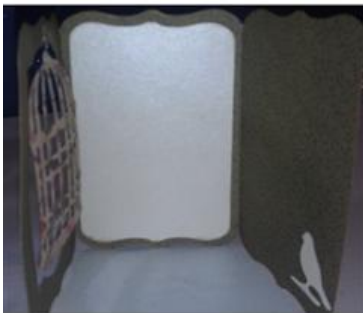
## STEP 2

Punch holes in the card and top of bird cage, apply brads or eyelets and tie the bird cage up.



## STEP 3

Put the rest of the cutouts on the card where desired. There are more bird cut outs than I used.
