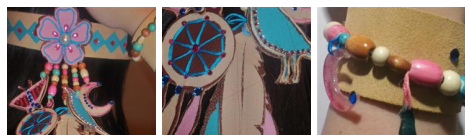


SOUTHWEST CONTEST HEADDRESS AND MATCHING BRACELET.

This headdress is fit for a native princess made with real leather, linen, and rhinestones. Also there is a matching cuff -charm bracelet.

OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

leather

heat n bond

rhinestones

linen

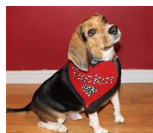
twine

wood beads

STEP 1

The tan leather was a belt blank cut to size as a headband and cuff bracelet. I ironed the linen to heat bond and cut images at 3 speed. The shadows were cut with a thinner brown leather I used multiple cut 7 times. The charms were cut at 2.5in and then shrunk with a heat gun. For the dream catcher I cut 3 images and then pieced together, the inner netting frayed too much (however I liked the shabby chic effect otherwise) so I wove embroidery twine through holes punched with a crop a dile. (see pic). The flower was attached the same way.

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
