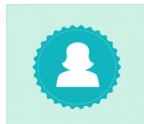




GECKO DOOR

I chose to use the gecko and flower elements from the cartridge and combined them to add to the top of the door to my hot tub gazebo. I sized the big geckos to 8" high and the small ones to 4" high. I then welded the flower images in varying sizes to the body of the gecko to pretty them up some. The sizes of each flower depended on what would fit inside the body in the spot I wanted to add them. Once all the flowers were in place on the gecko I grouped them all together and then copy and pasted to create the others. That way I only had to do that once and could duplicate it as many times as I wanted to.

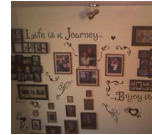
