OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Heat Transfer Vinyl

Heat Press

STEP 1

Cut image layers from heat transfer vinyl. Be sure to 'flip' the image, especially for text and other cuts where mirror image would matter! For my Expression, I set speed at 3, blade at 3, and pressure at 3. "Weed" negative space off of the backing, leaving only vinyl die cuts on. Place and layer. Press with heat press per manufacturer's instructions.
