| Small doily | Teal cardstock (1) |
| Corner rounder | White cardstock (1) |
| Foam squares | Light gray cardstock (1) |
| Adhesive | Dark gray cardstock (1) |
| Diamond patterned paper (1) | Black cardstock (1) |

STEP 1

- Type Candy Cartridge
1. Title: Class of 2012
 - a. White title (1 1/2" BetterWithChocolate + <class of 2012> or title of choice)
 - Phrases Cartridge
 2. Subtitle: You Did It!
 - a. Dark gray base (2 1/2" Layer/Shadow + Shift + <YouDid-s>)
 - b. Pink pattern layer (2 1/2" <YouDidIt>)
 - c. White title (2 1/2" Shift + <YouDid-s>)
 - d. Teal title (2 1/2" Layer/Shadow + <YouDidIt>)
 - Something to Celebrate Cartridge
 3. Graduation hat
 - a. Black Hat (2" <GradHat>)
 - b. Teal tassel (2" Shift + <GrdHat-s>)

STEP 2

Use paper trimmer to cut one 10 3/4" x 9 1/2" piece of diamond pattern paper. Use corner rounder on 2 corners. Adhere to one 12" x 12" piece of gray cardstock to create base.

STEP 3

Use paper trimmer to cut one 8 1/2" x 6" piece of teal cardstock. Layer together with two 4" x 6" photos. Adhere to layout.

STEP 4

Use paper trimmer to cut one 1 3/4" x 9 3/4" piece of pink pattern paper. Trim one end as desired. Adhere to layout.

STEP 5

Create title from cuts 1a. Adhere to layout.

STEP 6

Adhere small doily to layout.

STEP 7

Create subtitle from cuts 2a-2d. Layer together. Use foam squares to adhere to layout.

STEP 8

Create graduation hat from cuts 3a-3b. Layer together. Use foam squares to adhere to layout.

STEP 9

Embellish as desired.
