- Embroidery floss
- Ribbon
- Buttons
- Washi tape
- Paper clips
- Rhinestones
- Sewing machine
- Foam squares
- Adhesive
- Green plaid pattern paper (1)
- Small hexagon pattern paper (1)
- Large hexagon pattern paper (1)
- Light pink pattern paper (1)
- Dark mint pattern paper (1)
- Pink cardstock (1)
- Orange cardstock (1)
- Yellow cardstock (1)
- Mint green cardstock (1)
- Blue cardstock (1)
- White embossed cardstock (1)
- White cardstock (1)

Cricut® Cuts:

When I Was a Kid Cartridge

1. Photo Strip

- a. White shadow (9" Frame + Shift + Camera-s)
- b. Pink photo strip (9" Frame + Camera)

2. Camera

- a. White shadow (1 3/4" Shift + Camera-s)
- b. Mint green camera (1 3/4" Camera)

3. Stars

- a. Large orange star (1 3/4" Doodad + Camera)
- b. Medium orange star (1 1/2" Doodad + Camera)
- c. Small orange star (1" Doodad + Camera)

4. Title: PICTURE DAY

- a. White shadow (2 1/2" Phrase + Shift + Camera-s)
- b. Blue title (2 1/2" Phrase + Camera)

STEP 2

Use scissors to trim two hexagon strips from the large hexagon pattern paper. Adhere to one 12" x 12" piece of white embossed cardstock to create base.

STEP 3

Use paper trimmer to cut one 3/4" x 9" piece of green plaid pattern paper, one 3 1/2" by 9" piece of small hexagon pattern paper, and one 1" x 9" piece of light pink pattern paper. Adhere to layout.

STEP 4

Use paper trimmer to cut one $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 10" piece of dark mint pattern paper, one $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of pink cardstock, two $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" pieces of yellow cardstock. Use scissors to trim. Adhere to base. Use sewing machine as desired.

STEP 5

Create photo strip from cuts 1a-1b. Layer together with three photos. Use foam squares to adhere to layout.

STEP 6

Create camera from cuts 2a-2b. Use foam squares to layer together. Use foam squares to adhere to base.

STEP 7

Create stars from cuts 3a-3b. Use embroidery floss to stitch. Use foam squares to adhere to layout.

STEP 8

Create title from cuts 4a-4b. Layer together. Use foam squares to adhere to layout.

STEP 9

Embellish as desired.

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
