

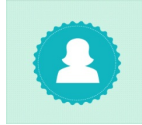

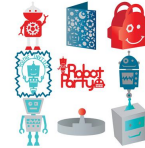
## CRICUT®: WHAT WAS USED

## OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

iron on vinyl

cotton t-shirts

iron and ironing board

baking paper

### STEP 1

cut your design in reverse with medium pressure and blade set on 2 or 1 depending on the thickness of the vinyl

### STEP 2

remember to put your vinyl right side down on the mat

### STEP 3

Remove your design from the mat and throw away all the pieces you don't need.

## STEP 4

Use your transparent sheet that is sticky to put your design on the t-shirt and iron it with hot iron without steam. Wait to cool and remove transfer paper.

## STEP 5

If you need to layer the vinyl, cover the design with baking paper in the places you are not layering.
