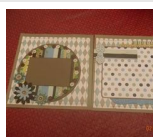
[etching cream](#)

## STEP 1

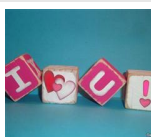
Cut the thunderbird at 2.5 inches. Use the cutout to make a stencil. Adhere to glass. Cover with etching cream. Let sit 45 minutes. Pull stencil off and rinse with cold water to remove excess cream.

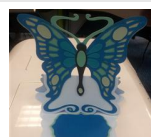
