OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Card stock

Pattern Paper

STEP 1

Cut white cardstock to 4" by 8". Score at 4" and fold.

STEP 2

Cut scallop circle out of dark red cardstock: use the Apple4 button with the lid option button and Shift selected. Cut at 3 inches.

STEP 3

Cut a circle out of white cardstock at 2.75 inches (I used the Plum1 button with the Lid button and shift selected). Ink edges of white circle with brown ink and layer on the scallop circle.

STEP 4

Cut strwbry1, Strwbry1-s, stem and leaves (on page 52) at 1.75 inches. Glue layers together and ink edges with brown ink. Adhere to middle of layered scallop circle.

STEP 5

Cut a piece of pink striped pattern paper 2 inches by 4 inches. Glue to bottom half of card.

STEP 6

Cut a half in strip of poka dot pattern paper and adhere to top edge of striped paper.
