OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

card stock

flowers

glitter glue

designer paper

lace

double sided tape

STEP 1

Cut 40 using Base Camp @ 2" or any of the other wonderful Cricut Font Cartridges. I cut 10 of each letter to build height to give it a more dimensional look, keeping the main focus. A great way to keep the letters aligned during the glueing stage, I used a couple of straight pins.

STEP 2

Easel Card. Using StoryBook

cut the card
Place the font
Cut a 12" x
Score and fold
Then score

STEP 3

Cut another piece of cardstock 6" x 6". Embellish as you wish. I stitched mine on the sewing machine, before attaching to the backing cardstock. Then tape to the front of the card using double sided tape only on the lower half of the mountain fold. This gives the card the appearance of an easel card.
