STEP 1

Cricut® Cuts:

Recess Cartridge

1. School house

- White windows (8" <SklHous>)
- Black roof/accents (8" Shift + <House-s>)
- Red bricks (8" Layer + <SklHous>)
- Yellow door/bell (8" Shift + Layer + <House-s>)

2. Phrase: Recess

- Black base (2" <Recess>)
- White letters: R/E (2" Shift + <Recess -s>)
- White letters: E/S (2" Layer + <Recess >)
- White letters: C/S (2" Shift + Layer + <Recess-s>)

3. Phrase: Learn

- Black phrase (1.5" <Learn>)
- White letters: E/R (1.5" Shift + <Learn-s>)

4. Phrase: Back to School

- Black base (2.5" <BackSchl>)

- b. White letters: B/K (2.5" Shift + <BackTo-s>)
- c. White letter: A (2.5" Layer + <BackSchl>)
- d. White letter: C (2.5" Shift + Layer + <BackTo-s>)

5. Reading boy

- a. Black pants/hair (4" <Boy2>)
- b. Red book/shoes (4" Shift + <Boy2-s>)
- c. Tan face/hands (4" Layer + <Boy2>)
- d. White book pages (4" Shift + Layer + <Boy2-s>)

6. Tags

- a. Four black tags (3.25" <Tag1>)
- b. Four white tags (3" <Tag1>)
- c. Four black apples (3" Shift + <Tag1-s>)

STEP 2

Fold top edge of paper bags. Adhere folded edge down, leaving a slot under the fold where twine can be threaded through.

STEP 3

Create school house from cuts 1a-1d. Layer together. Adhere to a paper bag.

STEP 4

Create phrase: "recess" from cuts 2a-2d. Layer together. Adhere to a paper bag.

STEP 5

Create phrase: "learn" from cuts 3a-3b. Layer together. Adhere to a paper bag.

STEP 6

Create phrase: "back to school" from cuts 4a-4d. Layer together. Adhere to a paper bag.

STEP 7

Create reading boy from cuts 5a-5d. Layer together. Adhere to a paper bag.

STEP 8

Create tags from cuts 6a-6c. Layer together. Tie twine to tags.

STEP 9

Embellish as desired.

STEP 10

Thread twine through slot of each bag. Attach tags.
