OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

- Cardstock
- Ribbon
- Bling

STEP 1

Cut banner flags at 9", I was able to fit 2 flags on each 12 x 12 sheet.

STEP 2

Cut font, assemble each, "flag" then assemble banner using ribbon, jute, twine, whatever works for you.

STEP 3

Cut butterflies at 10.5" using Indi Art. Assemble layers.
