## OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Ribbon

School stamps

Ink

Adhesive

Yellow pattern paper (1)

Aqua pattern paper (1)

Green pattern paper (1)

Brown pattern paper (1)

Red pattern paper (1)

Rainbow stripe pattern paper (1)

School pattern paper (1)

Kraft cardstock (1)

Cream cardstock (1)

## STEP 1

Cricut® Cuts:

Recess Cartridge

1. Medallion base

a. Aqua pattern medallion (5" Shift + <Ribbon-s>)

2. Apple

a. Cream apple layer (1 1/2" <Apple>)

b. Green pattern leaf (1 1/2" Shift + <Apple-s>)

c. Red pattern apple (1 1/2" Layer + <Apple>)

d. Brown pattern stem (1 1/2" Layer + Shift + <Apple-s>)

Essentials Cartridge

3. Medallion

a. Rainbow stripe circle (2 1/4" <Compass>)

b. Cream circle (2" <Compass>)

## STEP 2

Use paper trimmer to cut one 11" x 4 1/4" piece of kraft cardstock. Fold in half to create card base.

### STEP 3

Use paper trimmer to cut one 5 ¼" x 4" piece of yellow patterned paper and one 5" x 3 ¾" piece of school pattern paper. Layer together. Attach ribbon. Adhere to card front.

## STEP 4

Create medallion from cuts 1a, 3a-3b. Layer together. Stamp sentiment. Adhere to card front.

## STEP 5

Create apple from cuts 2a-2d. Layer together. Adhere to card front.

## STEP 6

Embellish as desired.
