## OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Card Stock

Glitter

Pearl or Gem

Adhesive

Glossy Accents

### STEP 1

Create a 4 1/2"x6 1/4" card from some card stock of your choice, in this case: lavender.

### STEP 2

Create two mats of coordinating colors, in this case: dark pink and white. The larger one (dark pink) is cut at 4 1/4"x6" and the smaller one (white) is cut at 4 1/8"x5 7/8." Adhere to the card base.

### STEP 3

Cut some coordinating patterned card stock at 4"x5 3/4." Cut a border to match your smaller mat, in this case white, at 1 5/8"x5 3/4." Emboss it with the Cuttlebug and the Geometric Rings embossing folder. Adhere this all to the card base.

## STEP 4

Using the All Mixed Up cartridge, cut the "baby girl" phrase at 1 1/2." Cover the phrase with glitter and then with glossy accents. Adhere to the card.



## STEP 5

Cut a small flower to fit over the "i" in girl from the same color cardstock as your card base. Adhere it on the word and add a pearl or gem to the center of the flower.
