## OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

DCW Spooky Time Stack

Seam Binding

Spellbinders Bitty Blossoms

Lightweight chipboard

Stick Pins

Hot Glue Gun

## STEP 1

I used a basic circle shape cut at 3.5" and 2.75" for the top and bottom pieces. For the body portion I cut a parentheses sized at 8.5x3.9" and trimmed the ends off to give it a straight edge. I cut one set out of chipboard and another out of patterned paper. Adhere paper to chipboard pieces. I suggest Xyron adhesive. Use strong glue or even better a hot glue gun to adhere the body portion together and then the top and bottom. Decorate as desired. I used seam binding, a Bitty Blossom and stick pins.

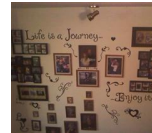
