| String | Red cardstock (1) |
| Foam squares | Peach cardstock (1) |
| Adhesive | White cardstock (1) |
| Die cut paper (1) | Dark brown cardstock (1) |
| Red pattern paper (1) | Light brown cardstock (1) |
| Green pattern paper (1) | |

STEP 1

- Cricut® Cuts:
Jolly Holidays Cartridge
- Santa
 - Red pattern Santa (6 1/2" <Santa4>)
 - White beard (6 1/2" Shift + <Santa4-s>)
 - Peach face (6 1/2" Layer + <Santa4>)
 - Dark brown sleigh (6 1/2" Layer + Shift + <Santa4-s>)
 - Reindeer
 - Two dark brown reindeer (6 1/2" Flip + <Reindeer>)
 - Two light brown reindeer (6 1/2" Flip + Shift + <Reindeer-s>)
 - Two white scarfs (6 1/2" Flip + Layer + <Reindeer>)
 - Two red pattern scarfs (6 1/2" Flip + Layer + Shift + <Reindeer-s>)

STEP 2

Adhere die cut paper to one 12" x 12" piece of green pattern paper to create layout base.

STEP 3

Create Santa from cuts 1a-1d. Layer together. Adhere to layout.

STEP 4

Create reindeer from cuts 2a-2d. Layer together. Adhere to layout.

STEP 5

Embellish as desired.
