| Chalk ink | Orange pattern paper (1) |
| Adhesive | Green pattern paper (1) |
| Striped pattern paper (1) | Blue pattern paper (1) |
| Multicolored pattern paper (1) | Dark brown cardstock (2) |

STEP 1

- Cricut® Cuts:
Graphically Speaking Cartridge
1. Tree
 - a. Brown pattern tree (4" Shift + <Imag01-s>)
 2. Title: the great outdoors
 - a. Orange pattern mat (4" <Image01>)
 - b. Dark brown title (4" <Image01>)
 3. Notebook paper
 - a. Green pattern notebook paper (4" Shift + <Imag42-s>)

STEP 2

Use paper trimmer to cut one 5 1/2" x 11" piece of blue pattern paper, one 5 1/2" x 11" piece of multicolored pattern paper, one 1" x 12" piece of striped pattern paper, and one 4" x 3" piece of green pattern paper. Ink edges. Adhere to one 12" x 12" piece of dark brown cardstock to create base.

STEP 3

Use paper trimmer to cut two 4" x 6 1/4" pieces of orange pattern paper. Ink edges. Layer with two 3 3/4" x 6" photos. Adhere to layout.

STEP 4

Create tree from cut 1a. Adhere to layout.

STEP 5

Create title from cuts 2a-2b. Ink edges of cut 2a. Layer together. Adhere to layout

STEP 6

Create notebook paper from cut 3a. Ink edges. Adhere to layout.

STEP 7

Embellish as desired.
