OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

Card stock glue

STEP 1

The lighthouse was a little tricky -- First, you need to get the paper to fit just right around the cans of beans. Score in equal portions to fit (will vary depending on your can size). Remember to leave an edge or lip on both top and bottom for folding and glue edge.
